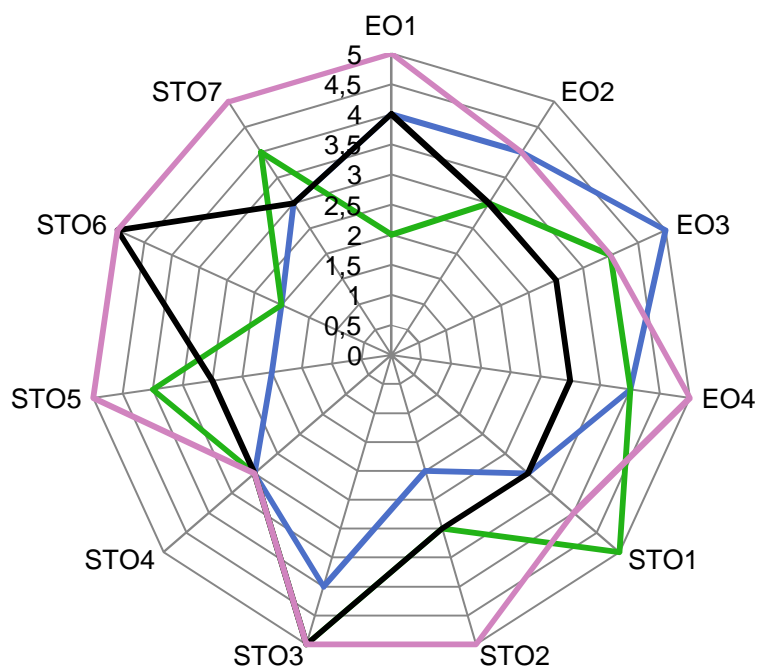

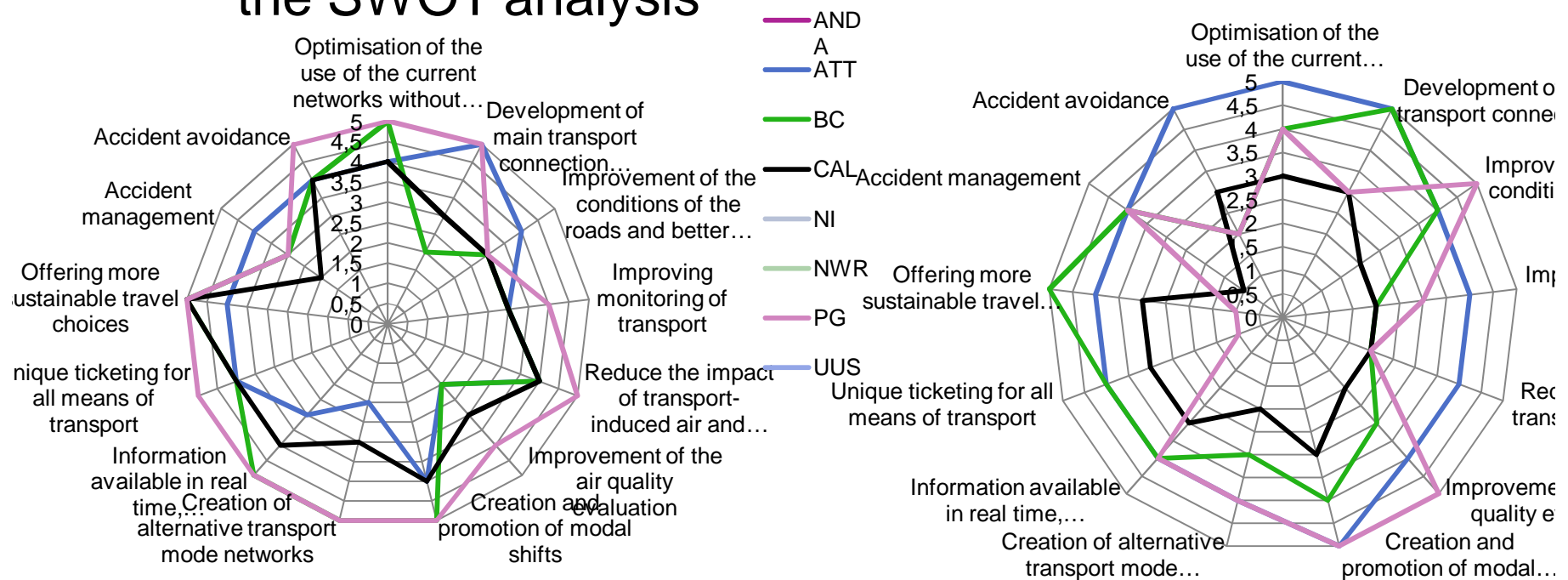

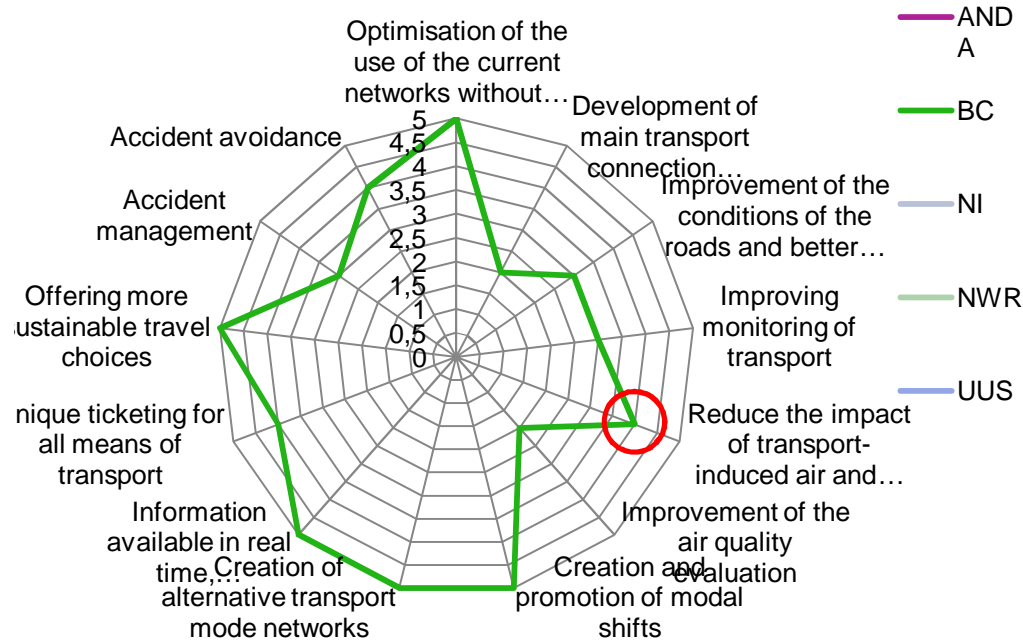

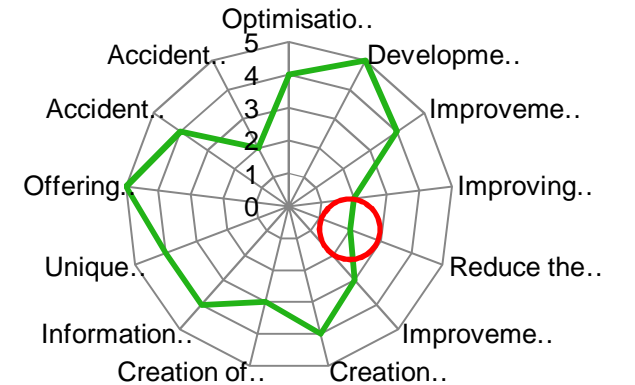

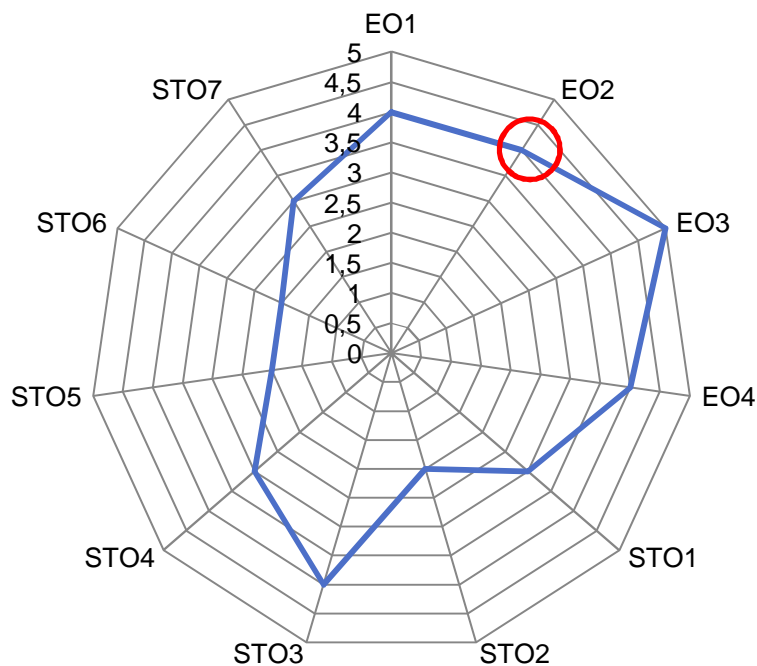

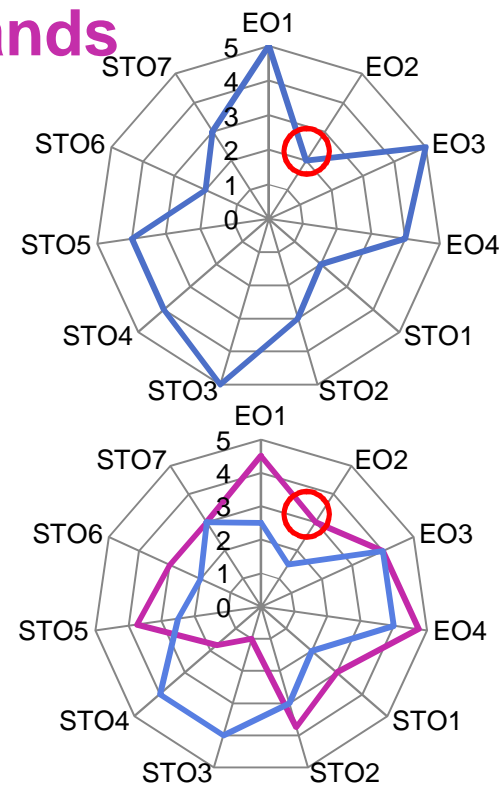


EO2 Identify market opportunities for mature RTD applications : Attica / East Midlands

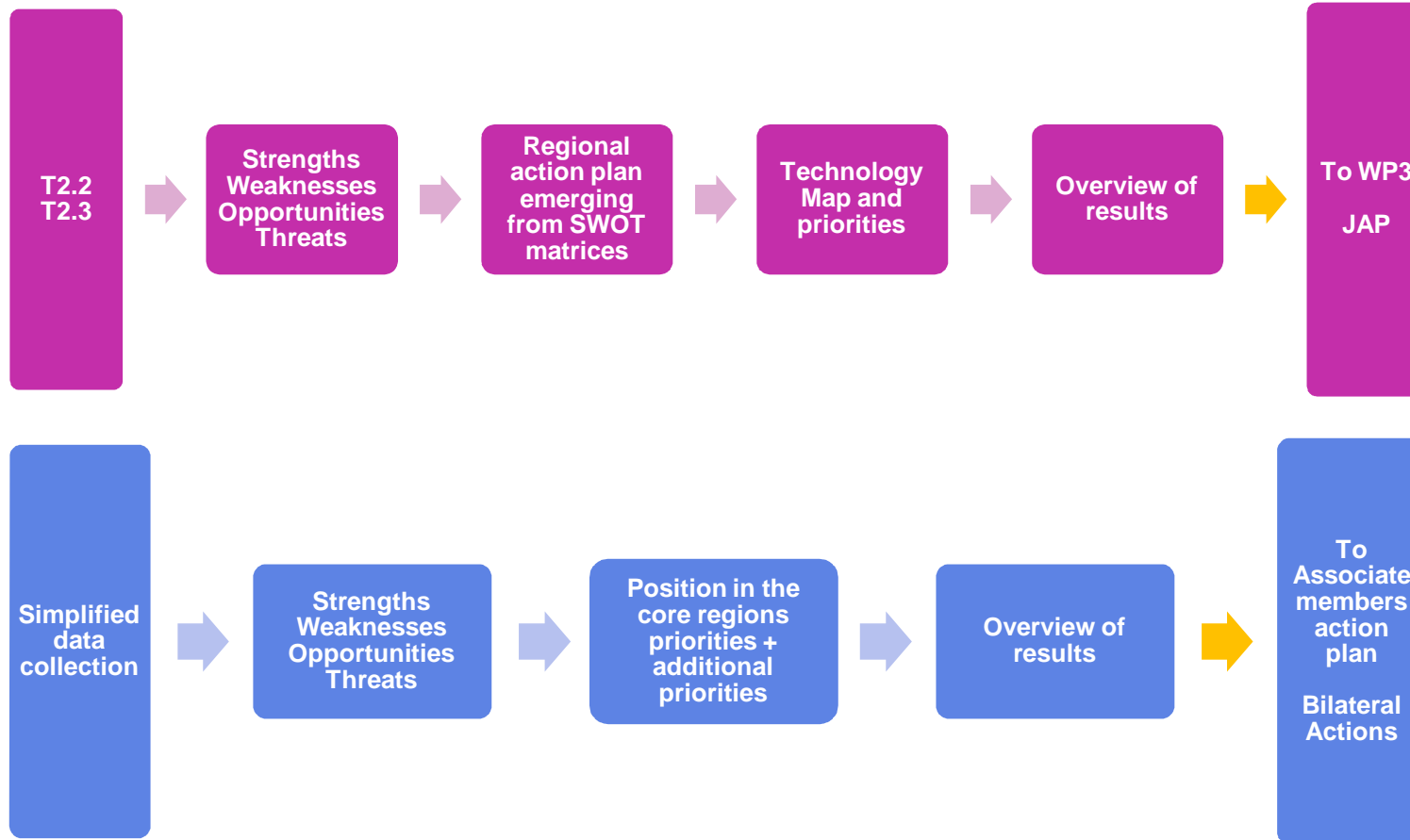
